The Review Process: What to Expect

>JSWE requires a minimum of 2 reviews

➤ We request a 30-45 day turn around for all reviews

➤ <u>Average</u> time from submission to final decision is 130 days

> Reviews go the Editor in Chief for a final decision



- > Accept
- > Conditional Accept
- > Reject unless Revised (also known as Revise and Resubmit)
- > Reject

If you get a Revise/Resubmit: Rejoice- and Revise!

Figure 5 should be in section concerning the effect of fossil fuel availability. So we removed the reference to Figure 5 from section 3.1.1, it currently only uses Figure 2 to develop the argument

their comments

- Caution should be given when referring to a group of scenarios, e.g. Page 6, Section 3.1.1, Line 1: the authors refer to the Baseline scenarios, but the statement that follows is not valid for all baseline scenarios. It would be fer to refer in 3.1 to the 'BAU DEF scenario' (versus the other default policy scenarios. i.e. 450 DEF etc) rather than 'Baseline scenarios' or '450 scenarios' all together. It should then be considered including only the results of the quant scenarios in figures pertaining to 3.1, and add the variations on other scenarios when these are actually discussed (i.e. sections 3.2 and 3.3).

We have modified the text to indicate that the statements refer to the group of the Baseline scenarios rather than to a single one (e.g. "up to 5 times" instead of "almost 5 times"). In other places the BAU DEF scenario was specifically mentioned.
